The Renaming of Dowling Middle School

The news conference was called to protest the proposed renaming of Dowling Middle School to the Audrey Lawson Middle School instead of the Carrie McAfee Middle School as the community had requested. Residents of the following subdivisions attended: Almeda Manor, Almeda Plaza, Brentwood, Briarwick, Glen Iris, Keswick Place, Meredith Manor, Pamela Heights, Ramblewood, Wildheather, and Windsor Village.

Later that evening, approximately 50 community members boarded a bus to attend the Houston Independent School District Board meeting where several residents spoke.
